
Remove the internal roof handles with the star screw driver.








Unlock the shelf retainer using the levers on either side of the main shelf. Move the retainers to the open position.

With the retainer in the open position, move the assembly into the cabin and align the mounting holes of the brackets with the standard vehicle grab handle holes. Fasten the M6 Button-Head bolts, the M6 Oversized Flat Washer and the spring washer through the shelf brackets into the vehicles standard mounts.

Once the one side is secure, repeat the process of fastening the shelf bracket to the vehicle on the other side.





Once the In-Cabin Cargo is securely mounted, you can close the retainer and it will automatically lock into place. Well done.
