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

1. Disconnect the rear bumper electrical harnesses, located along the inside of the frame rails on either of the spare tire.



2. If equipped, remove the three bolts retaining the rear slider reinforcement to the side of the frame rails (each side).

- 3. If equipped, fully remove the rear sliders from the vehicle by removing the two bolts connecting the slider to the rear bumper (each side).
- 4. For all models, remove the two bumper nuts retaining the rear bumper to the frame pads (each side).

- 5. From the back of the trailer plug, unplug harness.
- 6. From the outside of the bumper, remove the trailer plug by depressing the tabs on the sides of the plug.
- 7. Remove the two bolts located behind the license plate.
- 8. With assistance remove the bumper from the vehicle.



9. Remove the bolts retaining the tow hooks to the frame.

9. Remove the light housing from the bumper and retain it to be installed in the new bumper.

- 10. Remove the parking sensors from the bumper:
 - a. Unplug the harness from the sensors.
 - b. Remove the harness from the bumper.
 - c. Remove the parking sensors and carriages from the bumper.

11. Install the provided carriage bolts (A5) into the slots on the Warn bumper mounting pads and secure in place with provided push nuts (A4).

- 12. With assistance, hang the bumper onto the rear frame pads using the previously installed carriage bolts and install nuts (A3) onto the carriage bolts (four total). Do not fully tighten.
- 13. Install the provided frame mount bolts (A2) through the frame and in the stock tow point mounting location.
- 14. Fully tighten ALL hardware.

15. Reinstall the sensor plugs and license plate lights into the Warn bumper being sure to maintain the same orientation and location from the stock bumper.

NOTE: The locating tabs on carriages may need to be removed for proper fitment.

NOTE: For a cleaner fit of the inner two sensors, purchase a set of the outer carriages for the inner sensors to fit in. Contact your dealer for Jeep PN.

16. Reinstall the trailer plug into the Warn bumper and reattach all harnesses.

Installation is complete.

MAINTENANCE / CARE

- 1. Inspect all parts on the winch, winch mount, and related hardware prior to each use. Replace all hardware that appears rusted or deformed.
- 2. Inspect all nuts and bolts on the winch, winch mount, and related hardware prior to each use. Tighten all nuts that appear to be loose. Stripped, fractured, or bent bolts or nuts need to be replaced.
- 3. Check all cables prior to use. Replace cables that look worn or frayed.
- 4. Check all moving or rotating parts. Remove debris that may inhibit the part from moving freely.
