


43103 - Shovel Holder Pioneer Alloy Tray





43103 - Shovel Holder Pioneer Alloy Tray

Slide Support Block onto Body: Slide the support block onto the shovel holder body until the hole lines up with the hole in the body. Make sure that the wedge shape is engaged as shown.



Assemble Shovel Holder to Bracket: Fit shovel holder to the bracket with the hardware provided. Be sure when tightening the bolt that the channel nut sits in the correct orientation as shown, you may need a shifting spanner to stop the channel nut from turning.





Attach Bracket to Tray: Insert plate nut into the cut-out at the front of the alloy tray and slide the plate nut to the desired position. Fit the bracket to the tray with the hardware specified below. Repeat all steps for both shovel holder brackets.
