

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




ATTENTION! - READ THIS BEFORE YOU START FITTING THE AFN BULLBAR | BUMPER

AFN has developed an easy and quick mounting system, where the assembly part combines both the AFN Bullbar | Front Bumper(1) and Winch Bracket(2) that is fitted on the vehicle, at once.

This assembly goes from factory, fully tighted with shims. This is what we call the «O point of the AFN Bullbar | Front Bumper(1)».

The holes on the **Red Circles** must be correctly aligned in order to the AFN Bullbar | Bumper Assembly is on «O point».




ADJUSTING THE AFN BULLBAR | BUMPER

Every AFN Bull Bar | Front Bumper is designed taking into consideration the vehicle's original lines.


In order to give a good response in terms of design, resistance and functionality, we've created some ways to adjust the AFN Bull Bar | Front Bumper to the vehicle, depending on the customer's preferences.

- 1 When loosen -> allows the AFN Bull Bar | Front Bumper to be adjusted horizontally.
- 2 When loosen -> allows the AFN Bull Bar | Front Bumper to be adjusted vertically and depth.



8x Bolts that fixes the Winch Bracket to the Vehicle.

Horizontally (left and right) adjustings.



6x Bolts, 3x on each side, that fixes the Winch Bracket to the AFN Bull Bar | Front Bumper.

Vertically (height) and depth adjustings.

Step 1

Start by removing the OEM* Plastic Cover.

There are 8x OEM* plastic pins to be removed.

Then, go to the **OEM* Air Entrance** and loosen it so the OEM* Plastic Cover can be taken out.

There are 2x OEM* plastic pins.

(Be aware that you must save the OEM* pins.)

The OEM* Plastic Cover and **OEM* Air Entrance** will be fitted again later on.





Once that is done, remove the OEM* Top Grill.

There are 3x Bolts and one 1x Bolt in middle, as shown is the image.

(Be aware that you must save the OEM* bolts.)

The **OEM*** Top Grill will be fitted again later on.





Step 4

Then, remove the OEM* Grill.

There are 4x OEM* Plastic Pins.

(Be aware that you must save the OEM* bolts.)

The OEM* Grill will be fitted again later on.





Step 5

Now it's time to loosen the **OEM*** Plastic Fenders.

There are 6x plastic pins and 1x bolt in the inner side.

Then, on bottom, there are 1x flange nut and 1x plastic pin.

(Be aware that you must save the OEM* bolts and nuts.)

The **OEM* Plastic Fenders** will be fitted again later on.

Then, under the OEM* Bumper, there are 2 plastic parts, on each side.

There are 2x bolts and 1x plastic pin on the bigger part. The other one only has a fastener.









Now the **OEM* Bumper** is loosen, so gently force it out.

There are fasteners all the way of the **OEM* Bumper**.

Be in mind to disconnect all plugs of the Parking Sensors and lights.

If you done correctly, this is what it should look like.





Step 7

Once that is done, remove both **OEM* Side Plastics**.

There are 2x Bolts.

Be in mind that the lower bolt is fixing the **Headlight**, so we advise to fit it back as soon as the plastic part is out.

If you done correctly, this is what it should look like.





Step 8

Then, remove the *OEM** Central Reinforcement.

There are 4x Bolts in the front and 3x Bolts on bottom.

We advise to unscrew the bottom bolts first.





Step 9

Once that is done, remove the **OEM* Radiator Side Covers**.

Start by loosen the top plastic parts, they only have 1x Plastic Pins.

(Be aware that you must save the OEM* pins.)

The **OEM*** Radiator Side Covers will be fitted again later on.







Finally, remove both Front Bumper Brackets (inner).

It has 1x Bolt, on each.





Step 11

Then, remove both Front Bumper Brackets (outer).

There are 2x Bolts, on each.

Repeat this step on the other side.

If you done correctly, this is what it should look like.





Step 12

Then, it's time to remove the OEM* Grill, just gently push it out.

There are fasteners all the way of the grill.

Once that is done, it's time to carefully detach the cabling of Parking Sensors.

Then, with extra careful remove the Parking Sensors from the OEM* Bumper and apply them on the AFN Bullbar | Front Bumper(1).











Once the OEM* Grill is out, it's time to trim it. Just below the 2^{nd} line. (see the final result)

Bear in mind that this a precision task, so please take time to correctly trim the Grill.

You may apply some tape to mark the trimming line.

You may have to do the final touches in the trimming the grill. When it's done, and if you want to do a cleaner job, you may use a file to smooth the rough edges.





Step 14

Finally, it's time to remove the OEM* Fog Lights and Indicators

Every lamp has 3x OEM* Bolts and.








Step 15 - Preparation of the AFN Bullbar | Front Bumper

Installation

Before installing the **AFN Bullbar** | **Front Bumper**(1) on the vehicle there are some details that we advise to do first, in order to be easier the fitting into the vehicle.

Start by removing the Front Skid Plate(56) from the AFN Bullbar | Front Bumper(1).

You may leave the 4x Bolts M10x30(21) finger tighted in the Winch Bracket(2), so you don't loose them.


The Front Skid Plate(59) will be fitted again, later on.(these bolts are already fitted on the Bumper)


Then, remove the Plastic Mask for Fog and Indicator Lights(A1) -> (12).

10x Bolts M4x16 (B1). (these bolts are already fitted on the Bumper)

Also remove the **Aluminium Bracket**(70).

6x Bolts **M4x12(33)** with 6x Flange Nuts **M4(32)**. (these bolts are already fitted on the Bumper)






Once that is done, fit the *OEM** **Fog and Indicator Lights** on the **Left Aluminium Bracket**(**70**).

Use all 6x OEM* Bolts, 3x for each lamp. (red dashed circles)


Please note the triangles on the **Left Aluminium Bracket**(70), which indicates the right orientation when fitting. **They must be up**. (*red circles*)


Repeat this step for the other side, using **Right Aluminium Bracket**(71).

Step 16 - Fitting the Headlight Brackets

Before fitting the AFN Bullbar | Front Bumper(1) on the vehicle there are some details that we advise to do first.

Start by fitting the **Left Bracket for OEM Headlight(67)**, using 3x OEM* bolts. (see red circles, on picture below)

Then, take on **Left Headlight Plastic**(61) and fit 2x Plastic Nuts(30) on it, just like the image on the right.

Then, fit the **Left Headlight Plastic(61)** on the **Left Headlight Bracket(65)**, using 2x Bolts **M3,5x16** (31).

Once that is done, fit that **assembly** on the vehicle. (see picture below)

Use 2x Bolts M6x16(26) with 4x Washers M6(15) and 2x Nylock Nuts M6(17).

Give the final torque.

Once it is in place, fit above the **Left Side Plastic(63)**, using 2x Bolts **M6x20(24)** with 2x Cage Nuts(**25**).


Then, in the rear part of **Left Side Plastic**(63) use 1x T-Head Bolt **M6x20**(52)with 1x Washer **M6**(14), 1x Lock Washer **M6**(18) and 1x Nut **M6**(18).


Give the final torque.


The final step is to fit 1x **Headlight Reinforcement(69)** connecting the **Left Headlight Bracket(65)** to the **Vehicle**.

Use 2x Bolts M6x16(26) with 4x Washers M6(15) and 2x Nylock Nuts M6(17).

Repeat all of these steps for the other side, using Right Headlight Bracket(66) with Right Headlight Plastic(62), Right Side Plastic(64) and Right Bracket for OEM Headlight(68).








Step 17 - Fitting the AFN Bumper and Winch Bracket Assembly on Chassis

Installation

ATTENTION!

AFN has developed an easy and quick mounting system, where the the assembly part combines both the AFN Bullbar | Front Bumper(1) and Winch Bracket(2) that is fitted on the vehicle, at once. This assembly goes from factory, fully tighted with shims. This is what we call the «0 point of the AFN Bullbar | Front Bumper(1)».

The holes on the **Red Circles** must be correctly align in order to the **AFN Bullbar | Bumper Assembly is** on *«O point»*.

So, with help of another person or a crane, lift the **AFN Bullbar | Bumper Assembly** and fit it in the vehicle, as shown in the image.


Use 2x Bolts M10x35x1.25(48), with 2x Washers M10(36), and 2x Double Hole Washer(60), in the bottom.

Then, on top, use 2x Bolts M8x25(43), with 4x Washers M8(37) and 1x Nylock Nut M8(41).

Just finger tight all bolts

Do Not tighten yet.



Step 18 - Fitting the AFN Recovery Points on Winch Bracket and Chassis

Installation

Once the **Assembly** is fitted, it's time to fit Left Recovery Point(3) connecting the Winch Bracket(2) to the Chassis.

Use 1x Bolt M10x35x1.25(48), with 1x Washer **M10(36)**, on top.

On the bolts that fit directly into the chassis be careful so you don't damage the Chassis' thread pitch.

Use 1x Bolt M10x35(45), with 2x Washers M10(36) and 1x Nylock Nut M10(46), on bottom.

Then, on the side, use 1x Bolt M12x90x35(19) with 2x Washers M12(34) and 1x Lock Nut M12(50).

Also, on the side, use 1x Bolt M12x30(47) with 2x Washers M12(34) and 1x Lock Nut M12(50).

Then, use 2x Bolts M10x35(45), with 4x Washers M10(35) and 2x Lock Nuts M10(49).

Once the Left Recovery Point(3) is fitted, use 1x Winch Reinforcement(57).

Use 2x Bolts **M12x40(44)**, with 4x Washers M12(34) and 2x Lock Nuts M10(50).

Repeat all of these steps for the other side, using Right Recovery Point(4) and Right Winch Reinforcement(56).


Once both Recovery Points are fitted, i'ts time for the Lower Skid **Plate**(11).


Use 2x Bolts M10x35x1.25(48) and 2x Washers M10(35).


Please note that if you AFN Sump Guard Skid Plate - 48002732 to be mounted, use the supplied bolts for this case.

Just finger tight all bolts Do Not tighten yet.

If you have done it correctly, this is what it should look like.









Step 19 - Full tightening the AFN Bullbar | Front Bumper

Step 19 - Full tightening the AFN Bullbar | Front Bumper

Start by loosen the 2x Bolts of the Center in the AFN Bullbar | Front **Bumper(1)**, one at a time.

Then, fit the Plate Bracket(53) using the same 2x Bolts M12x30(27) with 4x Washers M12(23) and 2x Nylock Nuts M12(28). (these bolts are already fitted on the Bumper)

Now, it's time to check if the AFN **Bullbar | Bumper(1)** is correctly aligned to the Vehicle.

If not, loosen the Bolts of the Winch **Mount** and **ADD/REMOVE** the shims, depending on what suits better between the AFN Bullbar | Bumper(1) and the Vehicle.

The side shims(58) and (59) allows the corners of the AFN Bullbar | Bumper(1) to open or to close, depending if they are fitted or not.

The front shims(54) and (55) shortens or extends the distance of the AFN Bullbar | Bumper(1) to the Vehicle's fenders.

Mind that this is a precision task, please take time to correctly assemble this step.


Use them only if you have to, they are opcional and may not be needed.

Once the **AFN Bullbar | Bumper(1)** is in place, there is a tightening order to it. Tightening order:

- 1 Start by the 4x Bolts on the chassis;
- 2 Then, the 4x Bolts on top of the Winch bracket:
- 3 The 3x Bolts on each side, of the Winch bracket;
- 4- The 5x Bolts on each side, of the Recovery Points;


Check the Initital notes on adjusting the Bumper, on page 7.


Once everything is correctly fitted, Give the final torque.

Step 20 - Fitting the Wings in the AFN Bullbar | Bumper

Installation

Take on **Left Wing(7)** and fit it on the AFN Bullbar | Front Bumper(1).

But first we advise to fit 6x Cage Nuts **M6(25)**.

On the Rear, fit 5x Plastic Nuts M3,5(30).

Tip1:

You may use a screwdriver to easily fit the 10x Cage Nuts(25).

You may use a rubber mallet to easily fit the 12x Plastic Nuts(**30**).

Once that is done, fit the Left Wing(7) in the AFN Bullbar | Bumper(1).

Use 6x Bolts M6x20(24) with 6x Washers M6(22) and 6x Plastic Washers **M6(51)**.

Give the final torque.

Move the **Plastic fender** against the Left Wing(7) and mark the cut line. then cut *OEM** plastic fender.


After the Plastic fender is cutted, move it to the inside of the Left Wing(7) and drill a 7mm diameter hole.


Then, move the Plastic fender to the outside of the Left Wing(7) and fit them through these holes using 5x Bolts **M3,5x16(31)**.


Repeat all theese steps on the other side for the **Right Wing(8)**.

Give the final torque.








Installation


Start by fitting the Front Skid Plate(75) beneath the AFN Bullbar | Front Bumper(1).

Use 4x Bolts M8x25(23).

Give the final torque.

Once that is done, it's time to fully tight the 2x bolts on the Lower Skid **Plate**(11).

Give the final torque.



Finally, fit back both OEM* Plastic Cover and OEM* Air Entrance, that were previously removed.

Reuse all the 10x *OEM** plastic pins.


Reminder!




