




Place your tent on top of the vehicle load bars / roof rack bars






3.:

Lift the tent enough to place a bolt on either side of the load bar, front and rear. Position the tent into the correct place for your fitment.


Align the bracket holes with the bolts and tighten the bracket up against the load bars using the M8x80mm Hex Bolts, washers, and nuts supplied.





Ensure that the tent is secure and that all nuts have been tightened evenly.









Fitting the Load Bars to the Lightweight Tent Base:

Remove the Plastic Cap from the end of the load bar using a small flat screwdriver.




Slide 2 x M8 x 20 hex bolts into the Nutslot on the top of the load bar and fit one of the LW-BKT-LB-P001 bracket over the 2 bolts.



Place flat washers over the bolts and screw on 2 x M8 Nyloc nuts until they are hand tight.








4.4

Insert 2 x M8 x 20 bolts per bracket into the nut slot on both sides of the lightweight tent base in the locations in which you want the load bar positioned.



Position the bolts to slide through the holes in the brackets.


Tightent the brackets on to the tent using a 13mm wrench with the Flat washers and M8X20 Nyloc Nuts provided.

You can now fasten down the nuts with a 13 mm spanner, placing the nut caps over the nuts and then reinsert the load bar end caps.



Ensure that the tent is secure and that all nuts have been tightened evenly.
