

Maximum carrying capacity: VW Caddy/Caddy Maxi 100kg/220lbs. Evenly distributed over the crossbars.

Renault Kangoo/Nissan Kubistar 80kg/176lbs. Evenly distributed over the crossbars.

Note: Be sure to check the Rhino-Rack website to see if you have the latest version of instructions before beginning installation. Recommendations:

It is essential that all bolt connections be checked after driving a short distance when you first install your crossbars. Bolt connections should be checked again at regular intervals (probably once a week is enough, depending on road conditions, usage, loads and distances travelled). You should also check the crossbars each time they are re-fitted.

Make sure to fasten your load securely. Ensure all loads are evenly distributed and centre of gravity is kept as low as possible.

Use only non-stretch fastening ropes or straps.

Caution: The handling characteristics of the vehicle changes when you transport a load on the roof. For safety reasons we recommend you exercise extreme care when transporting wind-resistant loads. Special consideration must be taken into account when cornering and braking.

Please remove crossbars when putting vehicle through an automatic car wash.

Load ratings:

Maximum permissible load for Caddy Maxi and Caddy is 100kg per pair of crossbars, for Kangoo/Kubistar is 80kg. When crossbars are to be used in off-road conditions, please build a safety factor of 1.5 into this load limit. 67kg/147lbs for Caddy/Caddy Maxi. 53kg/116 for Kangoo/Kubistar. Although the crossbars are tested and approved to AS1235-2000, off-road conditions can be much more rigorous. However, increasing the number of crossbars does not increase the vehicles maximum permissible roof loading.






















Ensure Ladder is well supported on the ground to help support tent. Take extreme caution when climbing heights above 1.2m/4ft.







When these roof racks are to be used on a vehicle that is driven off sealed roads the maximum load rating must be divided by 1.5. Remember to subtract the weight of the roof racks to determine your maximum permissible load capacity.






WARNING! Important Load Carrying Instructions

With utility vehicles, the cabin and the canopy move independently. Roofracks and vehicle can be damaged if the item transported is rigidly fixed at points on both the cabin and canopy. Instead, rigidly fix to either the cabin roofracks or the canopy roofracks.












Remove the roof plugs using Torque Security key provided. Store the screws for replacement when racks are removed.





Renault Kangoo

Remove the roof plugs using Torques drive. Store the screws for replacement when racks are removed.

Roof pad orientation 2 bar system.

The top surface of the pads have FR-RL and FL-RR marked on them.






FR - RL = Front Right.

FR - RL = Rear Left.

FL - RR = Front Left.


FL - RR = Rear Right.

VW Caddy Maxi: When fitting a 2 bar system use FRONT mount point and either MIDDLE or REAR mount point. This depends on length of load being carried.



Renault Kangoo, VW Caddy






4 Align pads.

Before tightening make sure the opposing pads are parallel across the vehicle.

Tighten roof pads to 4-5 Nm.

With pads in place, fix crossbars using the M6 hardware provided.



When crossbars are not in use, install the mount cover plates as shown.
