

## RJHB Rhino Commercial - High Lifting Jack Holder Bracket

Important:


Please read these instructions carefully prior to installation.

Please refer to your fitting instruction to ensure that the roof racks are installed in the correct locations.

Check the contents of kit before commencing fitment and report any discrepancies.


Place these instructions in the vehicle's glove box after installation is complete.




Note: Product not to be installed on underside of crossbar.


Remove rubber buffer strip from the crossbar. Place the holder bracket onto the crossbar. Locate the channel nut into the crossbar recess, turn the attachment bolt so that the channel nut rotates and locate across the crossbar, tighten.




The high lift jack is clamped to the holder through the jack holes and must be periodically checked for tightness.



Check that the channel nut is fully located across the crossbar after tightening. Jack can be secured with a padlock as pictured in the diagram below. Trim rubber buffer strip to suit.



With the high lift jack inplace swing the clamp over the jack arm and tighten the bolt. Periodically check for tightness.
